The Traineeship is a two-year program that develops future ministry leaders. It involves holistic training and ministry under a coach for three days a week, and Christ College for two days. Trainees outside of Sydney can participate through distance education and intensive classes. Financial support may be provided to Trainees by churches and partners through the tax-deductible Christ College Scholarship fund.
