

## Christ College Exam Details

#### Exam Timetable

The exam timetable is available on the Christ College website (under **Resources > Calendars & Timetables**). Please advise the Registrar if you foresee any issues with your scheduled exams ASAP.

#### Biblical Hebrew A (Online)

This exam can be invigilated remotely or you can sit the exam on-campus at the time provided on the timetable. Please contact the **Registrar** regarding your preference.

#### On-Campus Exams

On-Campus exams start exactly at the scheduled time. Please arrive early so that you can setup in time and not disturb other students by arriving late.

#### Take-Home Exams

Some exams published on the exam timetable this semester are take-home exams. These exams will be made available for download on Nova at the date and time specified on the exam timetable. Exams in this format are to be written up as you would any other submitted assessment, such as including a cover page, using proper referencing and a bibliography, keeping to word count limits, and submitting on time. Late penalties for take-home exams are doubled: 6% of total marks available removed for each day late, up to 7 days, then zero. Submit your take-home exam in the portal underneath the exam download link.

#### Medical Supplementaries

If you are ill during the exam period such that you are unable to sit an exam, you must obtain a medical certificate stating this and the dates covered by the certification. You may then be granted a medical supplementary.

If you are sick on the date of your exam, DO NOT log onto Nova during this time and DO NOT come to college. Notify the Academic Registrar ([registrar@christcollege.edu.au](mailto:registrar@christcollege.edu.au)) immediately, and follow up with a medical certificate the next day. You may then be granted a medical supplementary.

Other than in the most exceptional circumstances, you will not be granted a medical supplementary if you do sit the exam and then, having seen the paper, decide you were too unwell to sit.
